RELAUNCH OF OUR SUPPORT FOR CHILDREN'S MENTAL HEALTH WITH A "ROAR"



We believe that mental health is as important as physical health and children learn best when they are happy and healthy. The ROAR response is a first line approach aimed at equipping school staff with the tools to provide early intervention and support to children experiencing mental health difficulties. It has been used by staff and children before. Now we are relaunching it for the new school year.

<u>What next?</u> - We will be delivering ROAR assemblies on Monday and there will be a ROAR Rainbow Morning on Friday 22nd September to re-launch our ROAR response. Children and staff can wear rainbow colours non-uniform (any colourful clothing) and there will be a morning of ROAR activities. There will be no charge for this event.

WE also have good news that, after a pause due to the remodelling of breaks and lunchtimes, our ROAR ROCKETS will also be restarted as "resilience champions" to support their peers at various times of the day.
