Wally Cain Dance Festival 2018

Dear parents/guardians,

Our performance for the Wally Cain festival is on Friday 22nd June 2018 at the Southport Theatre on the promenade. The children will be rehearsing their dance at the theatre during that morning. For the rehearsal, please could you drop your child at the entrance of Southport Theatre at 8.45am on Friday 22nd June. There will be a member of staff there to meet your child. You do not need to stay with your child once they have been dropped off, as they will walk back to school with a teacher.

For the evening performance, parents are responsible for dropping off and picking up their own children for the show. The children need to arrive at the theatre at 6.30pm to meet Miss Norris, Miss Fisher and Miss McCarthy in the foyer. If parents are staying for the performance, they will be allowed to enter the auditorium at 6.45pm for a 7.00 pm start. The show will finish at approximately 9.15pm and the children should be collected by parents from the foyer.

The children will be able to watch part of the show from assigned seats in the audience; however parents are encouraged not to go over to the children when in the audience.

The children should not bring any bags or refreshments as there will be nowhere to keep these backstage, or during the performance. Miss Norris, Miss Fisher and Miss McCarthy will provide the children with water and a small snack during the show.

Costumes

This year we have provided some costumes. However we would like you to organise the extra garments below. Hair and face paints will be done for the children in school, the afternoon of the performance. Please let Miss Norris, Miss Fisher and Miss McCarthy know if there are any problems with this. The children will need to arrive at the theatre in full costume.

If you want to purchase tickets over the phone, there will be a booking fee for each ticket purchased. The number of tickets that you can purchase is unlimited.
