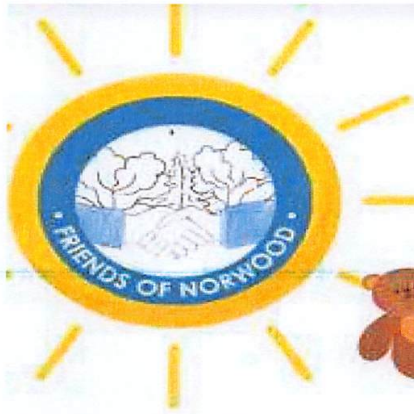

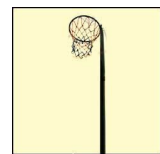
The next series of clubs start next week, so please make sure your child attends as places for many clubs are limited.
