We believe that mental health is as important as physical health and children learn best when they are happy and healthy. The ROAR response is a first line approach aimed at equipping school staff with the tools to provide early intervention and support to children experiencing mental health difficulties.

We are delighted to let you know that we are relaunching ROAR for the new school year.

<u>What next?</u> - ROAR assemblies will take place on Monday, and our ROAR Rainbow Morning is on **Friday 27th**September to re-launch our ROAR response. Children and staff can wear **rainbow colours non-uniform** (any colourful clothing), and there will be a morning of ROAR activities. There will be **no charge** for this event.
