

## TAKE UP OPPORTUNITIES AND COLLECT CREDITS FOR CHILDREN'S UNIVERSITY

Last week, the children had a special assembly explaining how Children's University works at Norwood. Your child should also have received a certificate acknowledging how many credits they currently have, whether this is from clubs inside or outside school.

Children's University is a national scheme to encourage children between 5 and 14 years to try new experiences, develop new interests and acquire new skills outside of the school day - voluntarily!



Norwood has been involved in supporting this programme for a number of years and this culminates in the Summer term with Year 2 and Year 6 children 'graduating' in a superb and memorable ceremony at Edge Hill.

While all the clubs that children go to in school are added in every half-term the outside school activities and visits can be recorded using a "Passport to Learning" available from the office at a cost of  $f_{2}4$ .
