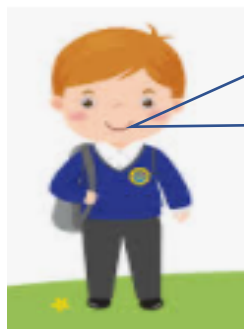


What Norwood have been learning about in Autumn Term.

I like reading because books are really interesting. I love to learn new things.

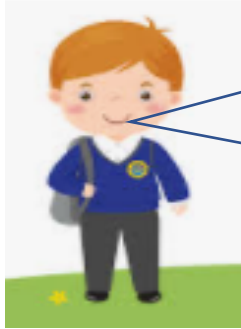

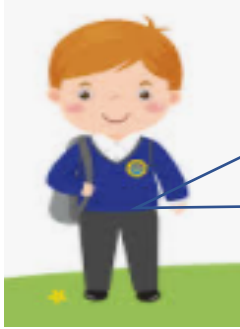

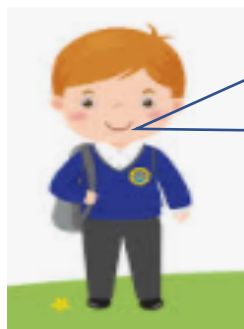
